Transportation and Infrastructure

Highways and Bridges:

- 326 of 326 projects have Notice to Proceed; 323 projects have started work; 111 projects are complete.
- PENNDOT reported to FHWA 6,748 jobs created or sustained for the month of April.
- FHWA has announced another round of TIGER grants worth \$600 million:
 - Pre-applications due July 16, 2010
 - Applications due August 23, 2010

Clean Water and Drinking Water

Program Projects Update:

- To date, PENNVEST has disbursed \$85.2 million (38.56%) of \$221 million in ARRA investment.
- Construction progress of the 113 ARRA funded projects is reported as follows:
 - Projects between 0 - 25% complete = 28
 - Projects between 26 - 50% complete = 32
 - Projects between 51 - 75% complete = 19
 - Projects between 76 - 100% complete = 34

Energy

Weatherization:

- To date, 6,962 homes have been weatherized.
- To date, 7,312 homes have had energy audits scheduled or completed and are in progress.

Application/Proposal Status

Labor & Industry

- State Energy Sector Partnership Education
 - ▼ \$2.45 million awarded to 8 grantees who will provide curriculum development, training and apprenticeship programs.

Department of Education

- Qualified School Construction Bond Program
 - ▼ More than \$600 million in bonds was awarded to 46 school districts for energy/water conservation measures and/or upgrades to boost early education or STEM initiatives.

Governor's Office of Health Care Reform

- Pennsylvania Health Information Technology Exchange (PHIX)
 - ▼ There was a great response from the IT community to the RFP, with anticipated award this summer.
