Transportation and Infrastructure

Highways and Bridges:

- \$883 million obligated (86%)
- 244 of 293 projects (total now includes first round of reallocation projects) have opened bids
- 212 projects have Notice to Proceed; 140 projects have started work; 8 projects have work complete

As of August 28, 2009

Transportation and Infrastructure

Highways and Bridges:

- Low bid savings continue to average 10.2% with an average of 4.4 bids per project received
- Disadvantaged business participation is tracking above average at 5.54 cumulative
- DOT reported to FHWA 3,304 jobs created or sustained for the month of July

As of August 28, 2009

Transportation and Infrastructure

Transit System Projects:

- \$267.8 million in Construction Contracts and Procurements awarded
- \$73.8 million in Construction Contracts and Procurements pending

As of August 28, 2009

Clean Water and Wastewater

Program Projects Update:

- 28 of 33 projects awarded in April have settled, totaling \$96.15 million in ARRA investment
- 27 projects have started with 3 additional scheduled to begin by September 30
- Estimated jobs as reported by the grantees who will begin construction by September 30 total 1,355
- Of the 85 projects awarded in July, two have settled and 78 have had consultations and scheduled settlement

As of September 10, 2009

Weatherization:

- State plan approved by DOE on August 25, 2009
- Provider Management Plans currently under review and revision
- Provider summit to be held on September 16, 2009 to brief providers on federal requirements, training and procurement
